Daniel G. Linzell, PhD Professional Engineer, Lincoln A complaint has been filed by the Nebraska Board of Engineers and Architects against you for offering to practice engineering in this state without being licensed.

Specifically, the Board was made aware of an online video clip published on March 27, 2016 by Standard Bridge and entitled "Standard Bridge website." The URL of the video clip as accessed is <a href="https://youtu.be/qV7Pcw3h0uo">https://youtu.be/qV7Pcw3h0uo</a>. The video appears to be plans and design details for pre-designed and pre-fabricated bridge systems that were previously published online at <a href="mailto:standardbridge.com">standardbridge.com</a> and on behalf of your company, Standard Bridge Co., LLC.

This appears to the Board to constitute the unauthorized organizational and individual practice of engineering in Nebraska. State law prohibits a person from practicing or offering to practice architecture or engineering in this state without being licensed in accordance with the Engineers and Architects Regulation Act (the "Act") unless such practice or offer to practice is otherwise exempt under the Act. Additionally, an organization such as your company must have applied for and received a certificate of authorization from the Board to offer services that constitute the practice of engineering.

Neither you nor your company are properly licensed or authorized to practice or offer to practice engineering in Nebraska. The Board therefore requests that you cease offering pre-designed and pre-fabricated bridge systems through Standard Bridge's Youtube account, or at any other locations publicly accessible on the internet, within 30 days of your receipt of this letter. If the offer is not removed, then the Board may initiate such disciplinary action as it is empowered to take under the Act..
